1 Introduction

MM Team Infusion is an infusion for PHP-Fusion Core 7 Edition systems with which infusion administrators can assign a user group as a team or create a new user group and assign as a team as well as they can manage the team member profiles. (except image upload)
Infusion administrators can set the maximum width, height and size of an image(to upload by team member) as well as they can set the maximum members to display per page.

PHP-Fusion infusion administrators can also activate, deactivate, enable and disable team member profiles, while team members can only activate or deactivate their profile.

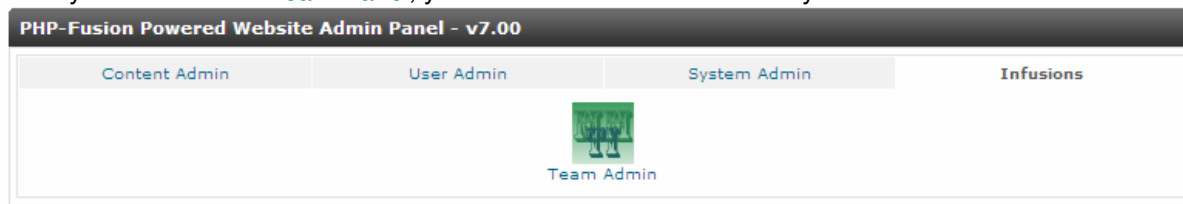
When an administrator disabled a member profile, the team member needs to contact the administrator, because the team member will not be able to activate or deactivate his/her profile.

Team members are able to upload an image to their profile as well as they can delete their image.

2 Installation

1. Download the infusion from <http://www.mvecommunity.nl>
2. Unzip v7.00_mmti_v1.0.1.zip
3. Upload the folders **administration** and **infusions** to the root folder of your PHP-Fusion System
4. Unless you are running PHP-Fusion on a local server, in most cases you will need to CHMOD the following folder to 777: **infusions/mm_team_panel/images/member**
5. Go to Admin Panel > System Admin > Infusions and infuse the **Mm Team Panel** Infusion

After you infused **Mm Team Panel**, you should see an extra item in your Admin Panel > Infusions.




3 Setting up a Team

There are two ways to set up a team.

1. Assign an existing User Group as a team
2. Create a new User Group and assign as a team

3.1 Assign an existing User Group as Team

Go to Team Admin





Go to Team Admin





As you can see, there is now assigned a team you created.

Now you can set the other settings, like:

- Maximum Image Width
- Maximum Image Height
- Maximum File size(kb)
- Members per page

The next step is to add members to the User Group. For this you have to use the PHP-Fusion build in User Admin > User Groups.

4 Manage Team Member Profiles

After you added members to your created User Group or after you assigned an existing User Group as team, the members will be displayed in **Team Admin** immediately.

All members start with the status inactive, because they are not added to the mmti_users table yet.



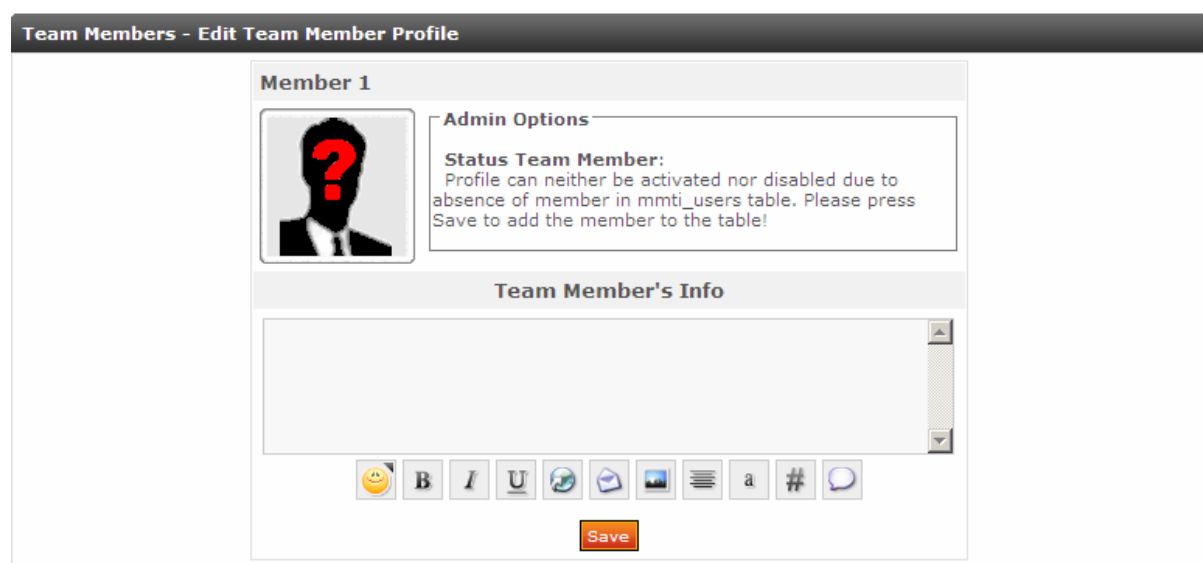
This means, that the member profiles are not visible for public, although the member can activate/update his/her profile when they are logged in. This will add the member to the mmti_users table. The infusion administrator needs to save the profile first, before it can be activated or deactivated.

Here you have two options. You can click [Edit](#) for editing a member profile, and you can click [X](#) to immediately deactivate a member profile, although the profile has to be saved once before.

4.1 Edit a member profile

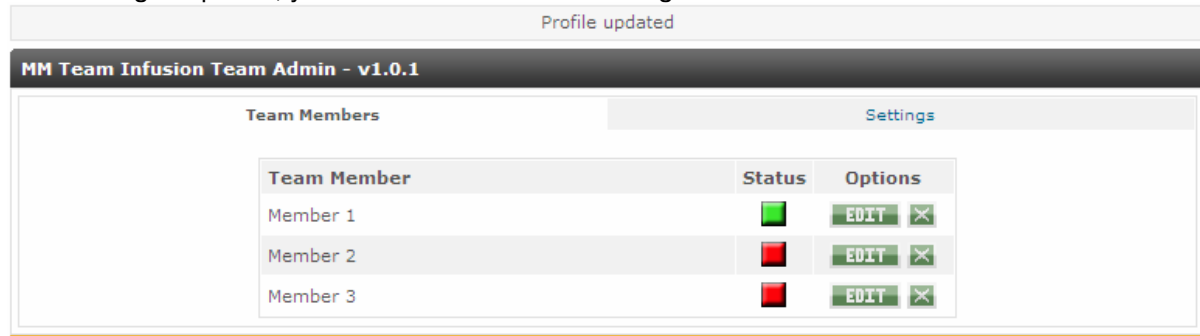
Click [Edit](#) to edit a member profile. Infusion administrators can do two things here. Edit team member's info and change the status of the profile, however the profile needs to be saved first, when the member is not present in the mmti_users table.

4.1.1 Edit team member's info



Here you can edit [Team Member's Info](#). It can be useful, when you disabled the member profile, to give up the reason why.

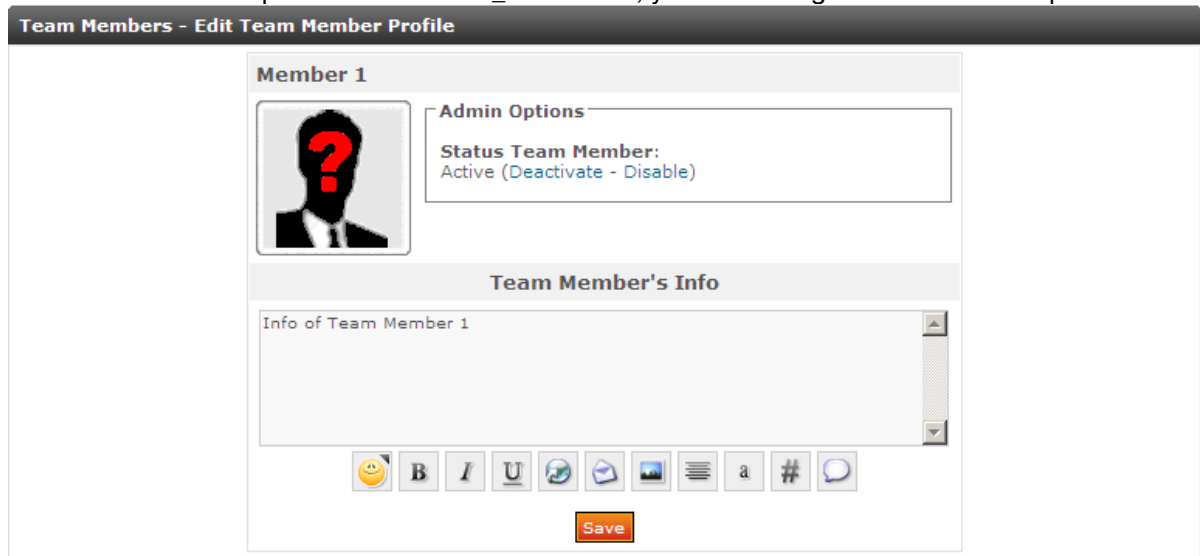
After saving the profile, you should see a status message like this.



You also can see, that the profile of Member 1 is Active.

4.1.2 Change status of member profile

When the member is present in the mmti_users table, you can change the status of the profile.



As you can see, the profile is active, so you have two options for changing the status.

1. [Deactivate](#) (for example, in case of hurtful member info)
2. [Disable](#) (for example, in case of abuse)

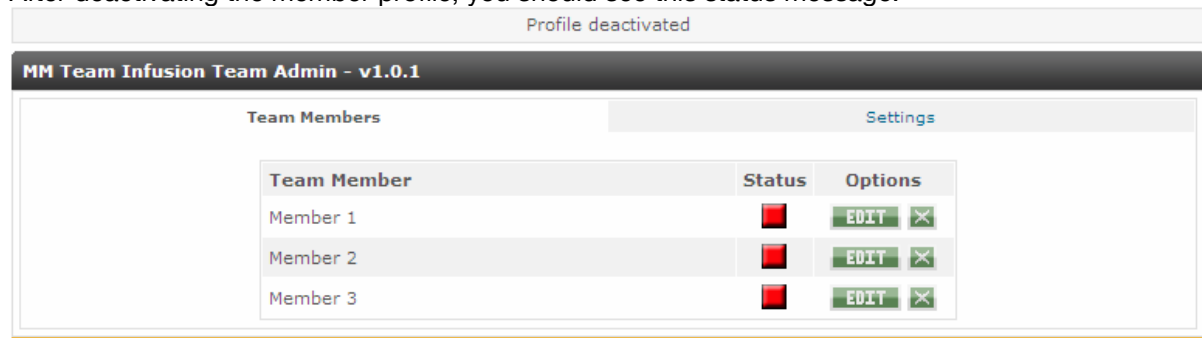
4.1.2.1 Deactivate the member profile

When you want to deactivate the member profile, click [Deactivate](#). you will get a confirm message like below.



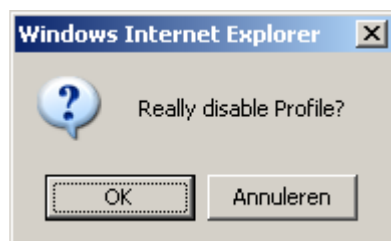
So you have the opportunity to cancel the action.

After deactivating the member profile, you should see this status message.



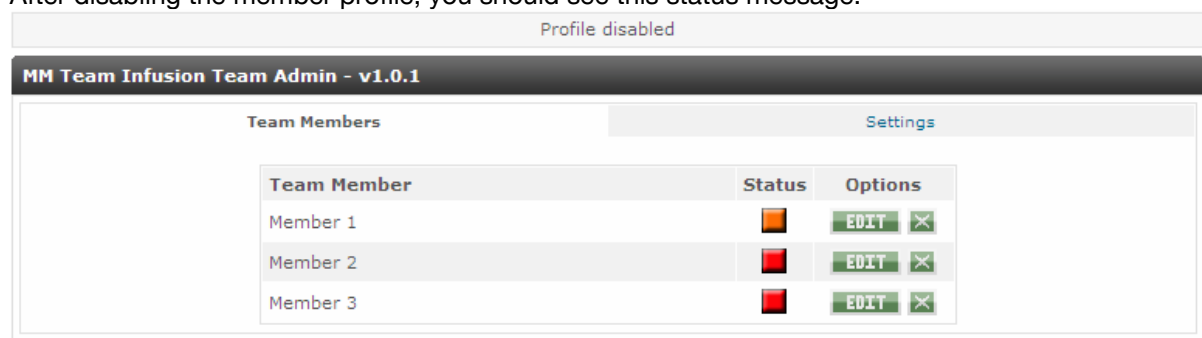
4.1.2.2 Disable the member profile

When you want to disable the member profile, click [Disable](#). you will get a confirm message like below.



5 Drop a Team

You can drop a team, for example, if you assigned the wrong team or if the name of your team has been changed or when your team has been canceled.

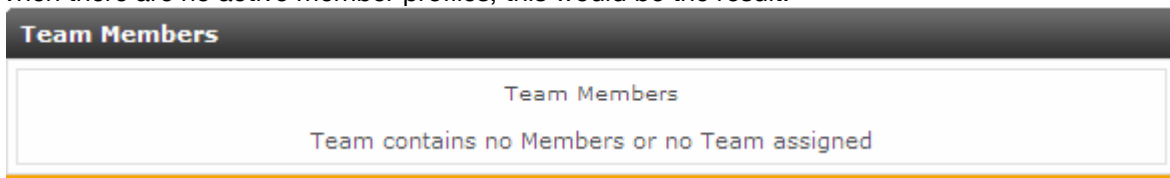
6 Infusion in action



When you haven't changed the name of the site link in Admin Panel > System Admin > Site Links, you will find the site link in the navigation panel with the name **Team**.

6.1 Public view

When there are no active member profiles, this would be the result.



Otherwise, this would be the result.

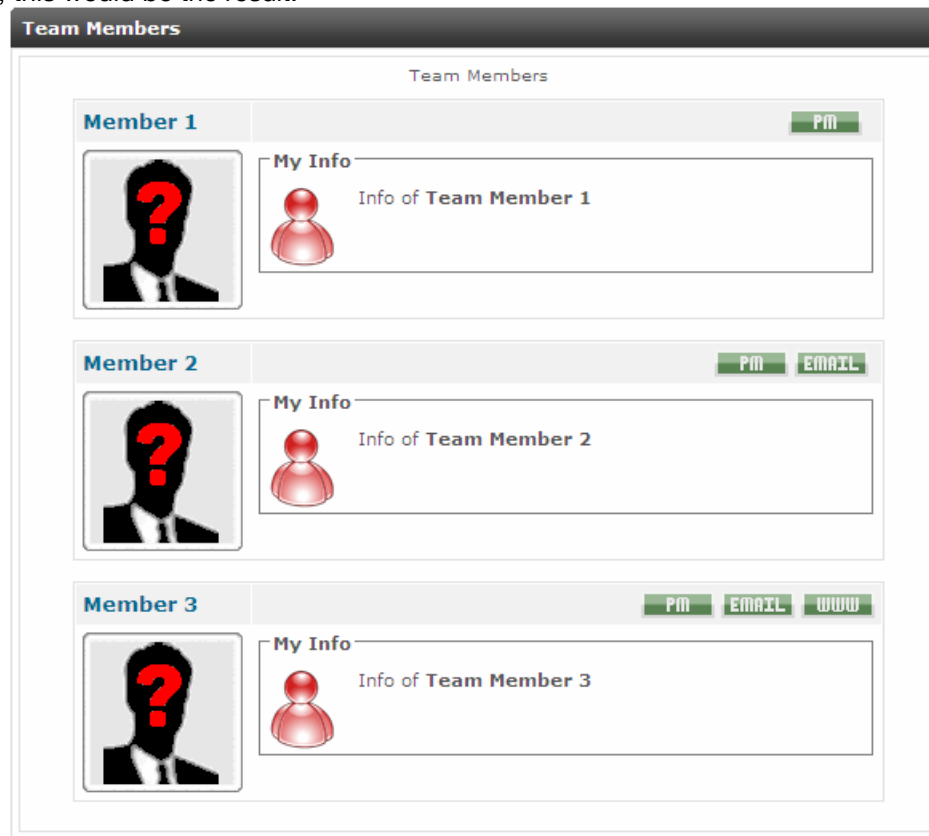







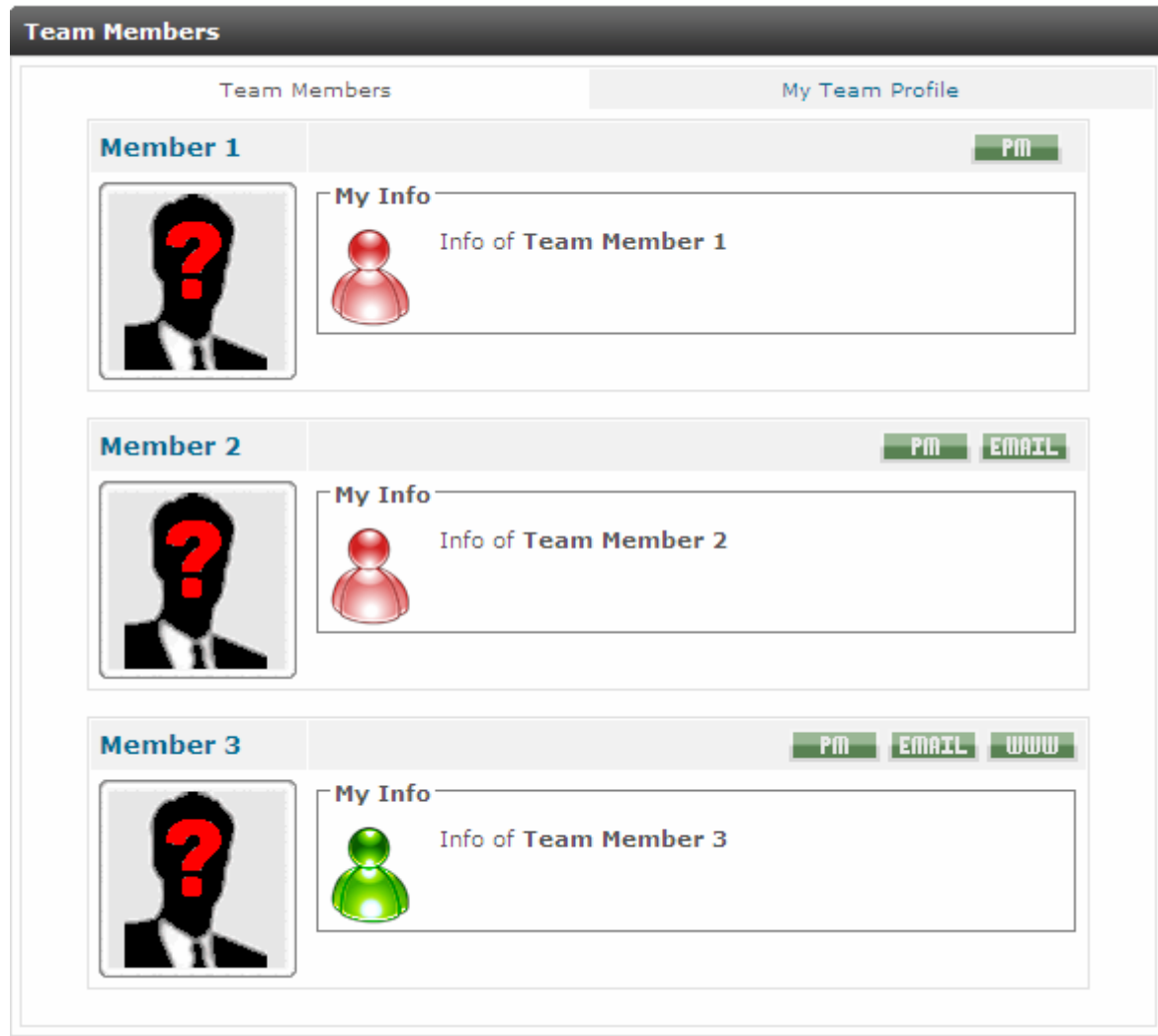

6.2 Member view



As you can see, there is an extra tab, [My Team Profile](#). This tab is only visible for Team Members. So if the administrator is not a member of the assigned User Group, the administrator won't see this tab.

In this example, Member 3 is logged in, as you probably noticed.

6.3 My Team Profile

Click [My Team Profile](#) for editing your profile.

Depending on the status of the member profile, you can edit your member info and possibly upload an image.

6.3.1 Absence view member profile


When the team member is not present in the `mmti_users` table, the member will get this view.



6.3.2 Active view member profile

When the team member's profile is active, the member will get this view.

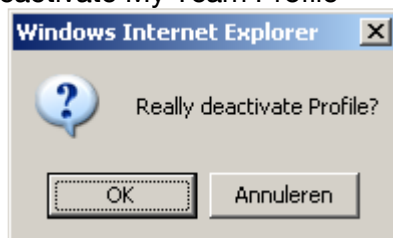

6.3.4 Deactivate My Team Profile



After clicking [Deactivate](#), you will be asked for confirmation so you have the opportunity to cancel the action.

When you press OK, you should see this status message.

6.3.5 Upload an image

The member can upload an image which doesn't exceed the settings, like the maximum image size and file size. In this case, the image size may not exceed 150 pixels and may not exceed the maximum file size of 150kb.

When exceeded maximum image size, you should see a status message like this.

When exceeded maximum file size, you should see a status message like this.

File size exceeded

When malicious code found in image, you should see a status message like this.

In case of invalid image name, you should see a status message like this.

Invalid image name

In case of invalid file type, you should see a status message like this.

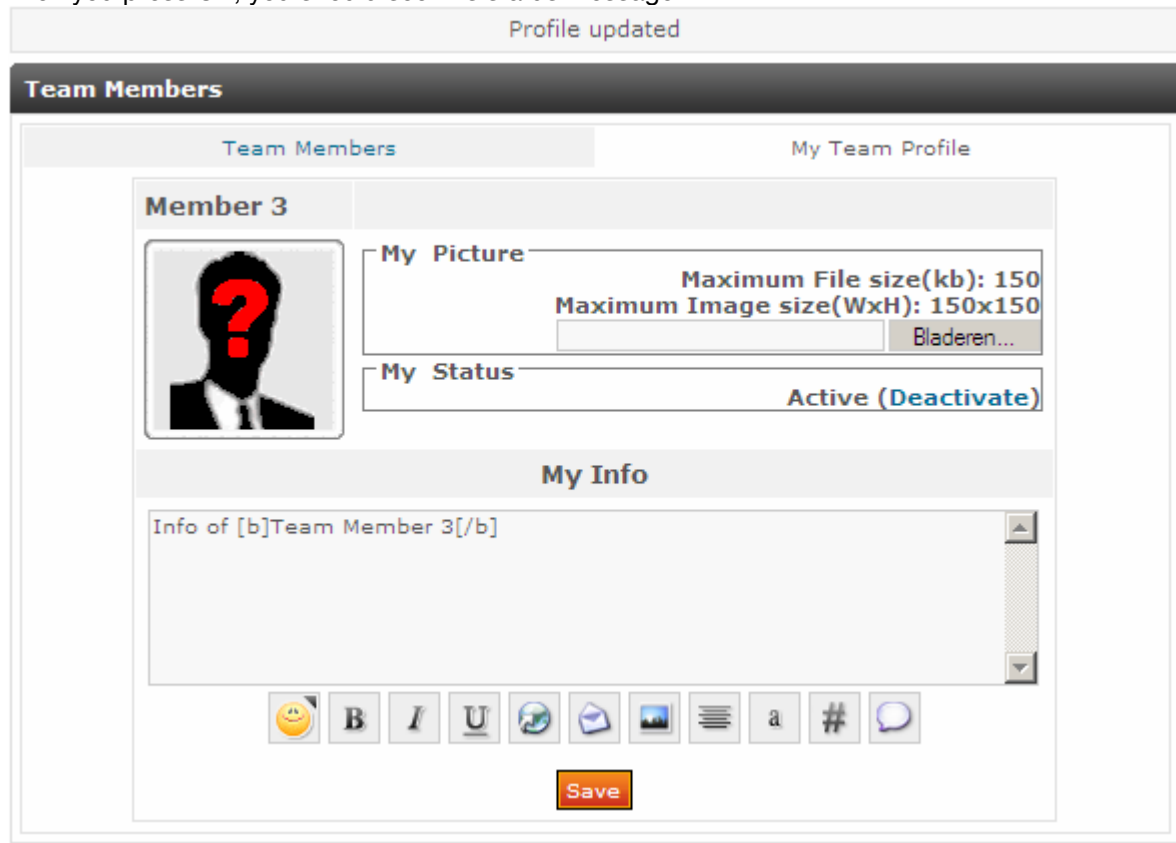
6.3.6 Delete an image

Of course the member can also delete an image.



After clicking [Delete](#), you will be asked for confirmation so you have the opportunity to cancel the action.

When you press OK, you should see this status message.



7 Uninstallation

1. Drop the team if you assigned one. (This will also delete all member images)
2. Go to Admin Panel > System Admin > Infusions and defuse the **Mm Team Panel** Infusion
3. Delete the **mm_team_panel** folder in the infusions folder
4. Delete the image **mmti.gif** in the **administration/images** folder
